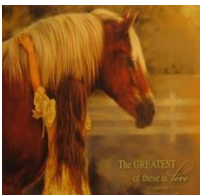
Community Garden – Provides gardening education and instruction in preparing, planting, harvesting and freezing/canning vegetables and selling surplus.
